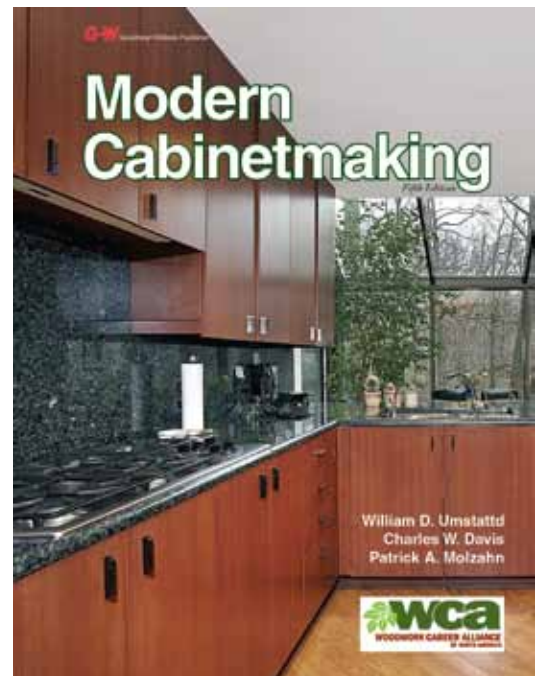

Textbook Update!

Congratulations to Madison College instructor and AWI WI vice-president Patrick Molzahn on the revision of the textbook, "Modern Cabinetmaking". This book, first published in 1982, is a comprehensive text focusing on the techniques used by custom cabinetmakers and woodworkers. While still providing classic coverage, the text has been thoroughly revised to include the latest in technology, materials, and processes such as CNC, 32mm system construction, ready-to-assemble casework, and grinding and sharpening. This edition includes over 750 new photos and diagrams showing updated technology and techniques. A chapter on employment introduces students to careers related to cabinetmaking skills, and a chapter discussing industrial organizations helps students learn how to get more involved. The text is also correlated to the Woodwork Career Alliance (WCA) Skill Standards, making it a useful resource for educators as well as industry members.
